Southeastern Showdown Update 2022

The Southeastern Showdown has been designated as a NHSRA Western Legacy Series Rodeo. This means that the NHSRA will supplement each rodeo in the series with additional funding. All of this money will be paid out to contestants. GHSRA will use this money to add \$1,000 to the payout for each High School event including reined cow horse. There will also be a \$1000 scholarship given to the All Around Cowboy and Cowgirl. GHSRA will not retain or use any of the money.

The Georgia National Fairgrounds has increased the cost of stalls. We are passing this increase on, but all stalls will now come with 3 bales of shavings included in the cost. The shavings will be in the stall upon arrival. If you will need more than the 3 bales you can purchase additional shavings through the fairgrounds. There is a link on their website and they will also put these additional purchased bales in your stalls as well. The fairground does not allow shavings to be brought in from outside.

For high school only, the Southeastern Showdown will also be a Hooey Junior Patriot Qualifier in Barrels, Team Roping, Calf Roping, Breakaway, Goat Tying and Steer Wrestling. You must enter online with the Junior Patriot or Better Barrels prior to SESD starting. Please check their websites to make sure you don't miss their deadlines. You will qualify by NHSRA rules on the 2 runs total, except for barrels which will be calculated on your first run. You must be entered in the Southeastern Showdown to enter the Qualifier.

The SESD will be a qualifier for the WCRA event in Guthrie, OK in the summer of 2023. This will be open to contestants 13 years of age and up. More information is on the WCRA website and will be posted when it becomes available to us.

There will be an optional side pot in each event in high school this year, cost per event is \$100.00. This will be split with \$50.00 going to each round and paying out 100%. This will not pay out on the average, only on the 2 rounds.

The Cinch Team Rodeo Varsity Cup will return with the same format as last year.

You must be a NHSRA member to compete in any of the Southeastern Showdown events or Qualifier.

Golf Carts will be available for rental again this year. Call 478-472-8565 to reserve.

Thursday November 10th -- Barrel Race (time TBD, will not be before 7 pm)

Friday November 11th -- Team Roping will start after Junior High Performance

Friday November 11th -- Breakaway (time TBD)

Jackpots will be run in Southerland arena where the junior high performances will be.

ENTRIES –

ALABAMA – Entries will be done by Google Form. The Google Form will open 8 am on September 26 and will close at 8 pm on September 30. This is a firm deadline and there will no entries after this point. Entries will be sent to Georgia in the order that they are received so enter early for the best chance at getting your performance preference.

Go round positions will be posted on www.ghsra.com by November 1st. The actual draw for placings in the rounds will not be posted on the website but will be posted at the arena prior to the start of the rodeo. Both go rounds will be random draw.

ENTRY FEES - PER EVENT:

Entry Fee / Round - \$ 45.00

Grounds Fee / Round - \$ 10.00

Total / Round - \$ 55.00

Total / Weekend - \$ 110.00

Reined Cow Horse has a cow charge added into the entry fees

Entry Fee / Round – \$ 85.00

OPTIONAL SIDE POT -

There will be an optional side pot in each event in high school this year, cost per event is \$100.00. This will be split with \$50.00 going to each round and paying out 100%. This will not pay out on the average, only on the 2 rounds.

T-SHIRTS –

T-shirts will be ordered using the link on the Ghsra.com website.

There will not be a vendor on site selling shirts. They will be preordered and there is a form on our website www.ghsra.com under the SEDS tab for high school. Deadline for shirt orders is Monday October 17, 2022 and if you are mailing in a check or money order the deadline to receive payment is Friday October 21, 2022.

ORDERS WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR PICKUP THURSDAY MORNING.

ALL ORDERS MUST BE PICKED UP BY THE END OF THE FIRST GO ROUND (FRIDAY NIGHT). SHOULD THE GHSRA HAVE TO CANCEL THIS EVENT, WE WILL SHIP T SHIRT ORDERS TO YOUR STATE. NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN.

GOLF CARTS –

Golf carts will be offered this year through Southern Golf Carts, and they can be reached at 478-472-8565. You need to reserve directly with them.

You must be 18 years of age to drive the golf carts.

ORDER OF EVENTS –

Bareback, Goat Tying, Saddle Bronc, Tie-Down Roping, Breakaway Roping, Steer Wrestling, Barrel Racing, Team Roping, Pole Bending and Bull Riding.

Reined Cow Horse will run both rounds during the 1st round (Thursday & Friday). More detail to come, specific times will depend on number of entries.

**Depending on the amount of entries in Bareback and Saddle Bronc these 2 events may be run at the same time with Goat Tying to follow.

CHURCH SERVICE –

There will be a church service held on Sunday, 8:00 am at the arena

GRAND ENTRY –

The only grand entry will be during the CINCH Varsity Challenge on Friday night.

SPECIAL GROUND RULES –

1. Thirty (30) second time limits will be in effect for all timed events.
2. In all roping events, the one loop rule will be in effect.
3. Western attire is required for contestants at all times in Reeves Arena along with your state issued back number.
4. NO air horns are allowed in Reeves Arena.

AWARDS

All Around Cowboy and All Around Cowgirl will receive Gist Buckles as well as a \$1,000 cash scholarship paid out at the rodeo.

Event winners will receive Gist Buckles.

Event reserve winners will receive a CINCH certificate.

In case of a tie for event champions, awards will be duplicated for winners and Reserve champion ties will be broken by a flip of a coin.

PAYOUT –

Jackpot will be paid on each go as well as the average.

The money for the first go will be ready to pickup 1 hour after the 1st go is completed.
The money for the second go will be ready to pick up within 30 minutes of the event completing.

If you are not going to be present on Sunday afternoon we can mail your money to you or send it via your State designee (national director, president, secretary).

ADMISSION –

Armbands will be purchased through the ghsra.com website.

Contestants are free with back number.
Children 12 and under are admitted free.

Advance weekend admission armbands can be purchased on the pre order link on the GHSRA Website www.ghsra.com under SESD tab in the top bar under high school tab for \$15.00. Armbands purchased in advance will be available for pick up at the arena entry door from barn 1 during each round.

Admission at the door will be \$8.00 per day.

ADVANCED PURCHASED ARMBANDS MUSTS BE RECEIVED NO LATER THAN NOVEMBER 1, 2022 and if purchasing after October 25th you will be required to pay through PayPal

HORSE STALLS –

Stalls will be ordered through the ghsra.com website. If you have JH and HS kids, you can have all horses placed together at either barn. Just be sure to fill out the stall request on the JH or HS form (whichever you prefer) using that contestant's name.

There is a stall order form on the GHSRA website www.ghsra.com under SEDS tab in the top bar under high school tab.

EACH CONTESTANT MUST PUT THEIR HORSE OR HORSES IN A STALL WITH ONLY ONE HORSE PER STALL. NO HORSES CAN BE TIED TO TRAILERS AND NO PENS CAN BE SET UP AT TRAILERS. THIS IS AN AGRICENTER RULE.

Stall cost is \$110.00 per stall for the 4 nights in advance and needs to be pre ordered through the link. Each stall comes with 3 bales of shavings that will be in your stall when you arrive.

If you need more than the 3 bales of shaving's you can purchase them from the fairgrounds on their website <https://www.gnfa.com/> or there is a form on the GHSRA website www.ghsra.com under the SEDS tab for high school that you can print and fax into them.

If you want to rent stall mats, contact Lisa Slaton at 478-952-6251. She will coordinate with the fairgrounds to have the mats in your stall when you arrive.

We will assign stalls according to the reservations and all States will be together if received in time. High School will be in Barn 1 and overflow to Barn 2 if necessary.

If you have a late stall request you may or may not be with your State or your other stalls. Stalls will be \$125.00 at the rodeo.

Stall fees will not be refunded without a Vet or medical excuse.

Stall reservations must be received no later than Friday, October 28, 2022.

RV HOOK-UPS –

Hookups are reserved through the facility at gnfa.com.

There is plenty of campsites with full hook-up. Arrange directly with the Georgia National Fairgrounds and Agricenter to make your reservations. Your reservation can be made through their website, <https://www.gnfa.com/> No generators are allowed.

All fees for stalls, shavings, armbands and shirts can be paid using one check if mailing together. Please include copies of the emailed receipts and be sure to include the contestant's name on the check.

You will not be permitted admittance to the fairgrounds before 12:00 noon on Wednesday, November 9th.

The Agricenter has a security gate with personnel on duty 24 hours. In an emergency you can call 1-478-988-6557. They are there only for assistance and have no connections with the rodeo and cannot answer any questions regarding the rodeo.

HORSE HEALTH PAPERS –

Be sure you have a *NEGATIVE COGGINS* on your horse. Also, check with your state regarding health papers required when crossing state lines, to and from the rodeo.
