



#6 ALABAMA HIGH SCHOOL RODEO ASSOCIATION CONTESTANT CONTRACT 2024-2025

CONTESTANTS: As a condition of membership in the AHSRA/AJHSRA, each contestant *must meet* the following requirements:

1. **Finals Ad Book/Sponsorship Sales** – *Every contestant* must sell a minimum of **\$300.00** in ads or sponsorships or a combination thereof. (Ads for the finals book, sponsorships, sponsors wanting banners, buckle sponsorships, saddle sponsorships etc.).
 - a. Finals Ad Book sales *must be* mailed or emailed to Ad Secretary, **Amanda Teal, 6231 Municipal Park Dr., Loxley Ala., 36551** or amv1605@yahoo.com, by the deadline dates listed below. *The email address is amv1605 not amy.*
 - i. **First deadline date:** One of the attached forms and a minimum of *\$150.00 in sales are due on Saturday during check-in, at the January Rodeo.* If you are not attending the January rodeo, payments should be **mailed prior to the due date** to the treasurer, Janet Fugate 8311 Bowen Rd. Baker Fl 32531. Also, (2) drawdown tickets are due at this time **\$200.00**. So, you will include the **\$150.00** for sale of ads or banners, etc., along with two drawdown stubs and **\$200.00** for a total of **\$300.00**. You can always sell more than the **\$350.00** due.
 - ii. **Second deadline date:** One of the attached forms and the balance of *\$150.00 or more in sales are due on Saturday during check-in, at the April Rodeo.* If not attending the April rodeo, payments should be **mailed prior to this due date** to the treasurer. Also, final (2) drawdown tickets are due at this time with their stubs and money that equal **\$200.00**. The **\$150.00** in for sales of ads or banners along with two drawdown stubs with **\$200.00** will equal your **\$350.00** due.
 - b. Your **sales responsibility** may be sold through ads, sponsorships, awards, banners, etc.
 - c. **There will be a \$100 per rodeo weekend late fee for any deadlines not met. You will not be eligible to rodeo until ad/sponsor sales are met.**
 - d. You are responsible for collecting and mailing any ads or sponsorships sold along with either of the forms attached, including pictures, business cards, etc. to complete ads which will not be returned. The Ad Secretary information is indicated above in section a.
 - e. Please make sure that you include the contestant's name and back number on all the checks, ads, and forms to receive credit for the ads and sponsorships sold.
 - f. Complete the State Sponsorship form and/or Finals Ad Book **Form with each sale.**
2. **Finals Ad Book Sales Sponsor Incentive Program:** Any contestant selling **additional** ad/sponsor money as indicated below will receive incentive money. This money will **not be paid out until State Finals dinner time. You will receive 10% of your additional sales. Like \$1,000 in additional sales the contestant will receive \$100.00.**



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3. **Drawdown Ticket Sales** – Every contestant *must sell a minimum of four (4) drawdown tickets*. Each ticket is \$100.00. Drawdown tickets must be handled as follows:
 - a. **First deadline date:** *Two tickets or a minimum of \$200 is due on Saturday during check-in of the January Rodeo. IF you are not attending the January rodeo, payment of \$200 should be mailed prior to the due date to the AHSRA treasurer; Janet Fugate, 8311 Bowen Rd., Baker Fl 32531.*
 - b. **Second deadline date:** *Two tickets or the balance of \$200 or more are due on Saturday, during check-in of the April Rodeo. IF you are not attending the April rodeo, payments should be mailed prior to the due date to the AHSRA treasurer.*
 - c. The drawdown dinner will be held at the Alabama High School Finals, that date will be announced closer to that time. If you want to sell more than the four tickets you are allowed to get more at any time, just ask the treasurer.

4. **Family Work Hours**- *Every contestant's family can do work hours throughout the rodeo year. A minimum of 20 hours are required* of AHSRA/AJHSRA contestants. Work at the rodeo, work any function, cutting, open gates, set poles, barrels or other assignment that any volunteer help is needed, this helps your child to complete their required work hours, they too must put in work hours.
 - a. There will be opportunities for all families to sign up for these hours in and out of the arena, including but not limited too event directors, door entry, concessions, grounds/arena help, committees and event set up.
 - b. Contestants will receive 2 work hour cards in their membership packet. Keep them in your wallet, once you work your volunteer hours get your box on the card initialed by a director of the event you worked. Once you have your card filled, you will ***turn it in to Janet Fugate- treasurer, or Mrs. Kim DeFelix Secretary. You may pick up more cards as needed from Mrs. Janet.*** Every card you fill with “***an event director's initials***” or a ***Board Officer that had you doing certain work***, will go into a drawing for at the end of the year.
 - c. All work hours must be completed by the end of the last *regular season rodeo in May*.
 - d. If a family/contestant chooses not to work the 20 hours or fails to complete the work hours, the family shall pay \$500.00 in order to be eligible to receive awards during the State Finals Awards Dinner. Each card is a \$250 charge of hours so if you fill in one card and not the other, you pay \$250.00 for the blank card. ***The two cards must be turned in before the week of finals or the contestant is due the \$500.00 in order to rodeo at the finals.***

#7 HOME SCHOOL VERIFICATION FORM

In accordance with the NHSRA rulebook pertaining to contestant qualifications, students who attend a Homeschool, private school, religious school or correspondence school are eligible for membership if the school is recognized and approved by the state/province Board of Education or National Board of Education in the state/province the member is applying for membership. The contestant would need to show proof that the school they are attending is accredited and that they have met the grade requirements.

If the school the student is attending is not accredited by the State or National Board of Education the Student shall demonstrate composite grade-level academic proficiency on any State Board or National Board of Education recognized achievement test or other mechanism as provided for in State or National Board or Education rules. A student shall be eligible if they achieve a minimum composite score or survey test score within the average or higher than average range as established by the test service utilized on any nationally normed test.
